

- The abstract should not be more than 300 words, and the full paper should not be more than 3000 words with headings. Both should contain the title of the paper, name, designation, institutional affiliation of the authors and contact details of the presenting author.
- Acceptance of papers will be communicated to participants within three days of submission.
- Authors are advised to ensure that their submissions are plagiarism-free. The selected paper will be forwarded and published in institutional journal, with ISBN No.
