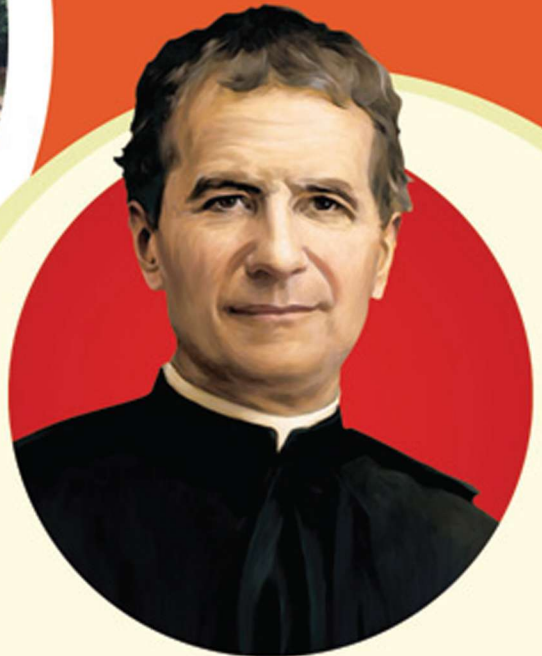

## STUDENTS' FACILITIES

### COMPUTER LAB

The students are provided with a well-equipped computer lab with machines that have the latest Pentium processors. The lab is open to the students from 8.40 am to 07.30 pm. The lab is air conditioned and is conducive to creative programming.

### INTERNET

The college has high speed internet over fibre network. Free access to internet facilities, including WiFi access, is provided to all students, 24x7. All students are encouraged to use this facility for academic purpose.

### LIBRARY

The college has a well-stocked library, with over 7000 volumes under 1050 titles and 24 journals, both Indian and foreign. The library also has a collection of e-books. The library is fully automated and net-enabled. The college has subscription to digital library specified by AICTE. Ten systems are available in the library for accessing the digital library. The digital library can also be accessed from any computer in the campus. The library is open from 8.30 am to 7.30 pm on all days, excluding Sundays.



## LANGUAGE LAB

The medium of communication in the campus is English and it shall be strictly adhered to. The students are also prepared to use English through language initiation courses, spoken English classes and follow up mechanisms. A 15 user language lab is available for those who wish to perfect their communication skills.

## MEN'S HOSTEL

Men's hostel (Savio Home) is a well-furnished three-storied building with lodging facility for 160 students. The hostel is managed under the direct supervision of the Don Bosco fathers. An atmosphere of serious study, cordiality and family spirit reigns in the hostel. The hostel has facilities for sports, games and other recreations. Mess is available in the hostel and is managed by the students.

## WOMEN'S HOSTEL

Women's Hostel is a well-furnished two-storied building managed by the FSM sisters. The hostel is well administered with lodging facility for 100 students.

## CANTEEN

College has a well-established cafeteria. Canteen is spick and span, and offers items of quality at an affordable rate. Canteen functions on all working days.

## DRESS CODE

All students shall wear the prescribed uniform, while in the campus.

## MCA ASSOCIATION

MCA association functions to facilitate the integral development of the members. It organizes seminars, workshops, training in soft skills and other personality development programmes. All the students are members of MCA association. The association organizes intra-college and inter-collegiate programmes under the guidance of the staff.

## PLACEMENT CELL

Placement cell in the college functions with the objective of identifying and facilitating placement opportunities for the students with their cooperation. Soft skill development workshops, training in aptitude, group discussions and mock interviews are organized in view of equipping the students.





## ENTREPRENEURIAL DEVELOPMENT CELL

The college has an entrepreneurial development cell, funded by the government of Kerala. Several entrepreneurial training activities are carried out by this cell. Additional training in latest skills, legal knowledge, industrial visits, opportunities to meet entrepreneurs etc. are provided by this cell.

## BHOO MITRA SENA CLUB

The college has a unit of Bhoo Mitra Sena Club, funded by the Government of Kerala. It carries out activities related to environment protection.

## RED RIBBON CLUB

The Red Ribbon Club of the college is funded by the Government of Kerala. It is active in the areas of promoting health and hygiene among the villagers, conscientising the students and villagers about blood donation, organ donation etc.

## CULTURAL ENRICHMENT

The students are culturally enriched with the celebration of important festivals and celebrations of the year. The active participation of the students in the organization of events like Onam, Christmas and other festivals are means of an integral education.

## INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION

The college has an informal MoU with Global Education Network (GLEN) for internship. Under this agreement, students from European countries come to the college for three months of internship. Interacting with these interns offer an opportunity for the students to understand various cultures and improve their communication skills.





## ARTS AND SPORTS

The college has playgrounds for football, cricket, volleyball, basketball and shuttle. They also have ample space for indoor games. Arts day and sports day are organized annually with due importance in order to ensure the holistic and integral formation of the students.

## ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The college has an alumni association. The group has seven chapters, including one chapter in the Gulf region. Members are active over WhatsApp. The Alumni association supports the MCA association programmes. Annual meetings are organized for the alumni, in each chapter. Interaction of the present students with past pupils employed in industry serves as a motivating factor.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Thanangattu Family Scholarship is set up with the generous contribution of Mr. Thanangattu Thomas. An amount of Rs. 50,000/- per year is distributed as scholarship for the best performing PG students of Don Bosco Campus. Achievements in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are considered while selecting the recipients.
2. Rev. Bro. Shaji Kalavanal Memorial Scholarship is established by the alumni of the first three batches, in honour of Rev. Bro. Shaji Kalavanal, the first principal of the college. Three scholarships are given each year.
3. Don Bosco-tekVizion Scholarship is established by the alumni of the college working in tekVizion Voice Solutions. It is given to the student who receives highest mark in the subject 'Software Engineering'.
4. Mullu Centil Memorial Scholarship is established by the staff and companions of Ms. Mullu Centil, former student of the college, who passed away on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2017. The scholarship is instituted to encourage co-curricular and extra-curricular activities among the students.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applicants are required to apply on the prescribed application form available at [www.dbc.ac.in](http://www.dbc.ac.in). Application form is also available from the college office.

50% of the seats are filled by DTE/LBS through centralized allotment. Students desirous of these merit seats have to apply online through the web portal prescribed by DTE/LBS. They need to approach the college with the proof of admission issued by the competent authority. The remaining 50% of the seats are filled by the management. Students seeking admission to these seats may approach the college, with their entrance scores. The admissions will begin and close as per the guidelines of AICTE and university.



## ELIGIBILITY

**MCA 2 years:-** Students who have passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree. OR Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University). Obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination

In order to obtain admission to MCA program in the College, the candidate should have written the entrance examination conducted by LBS and obtained a minimum of 5% of marks.

## GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

- a. Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline inside and outside the college campus.
- b. Students must abide by the rules and regulations of the college and should not do anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with the orderly working, discipline and reputation of the college.

- d. Publishing of any materials in any form anywhere inside the campus can be done with the permission of the principal only.

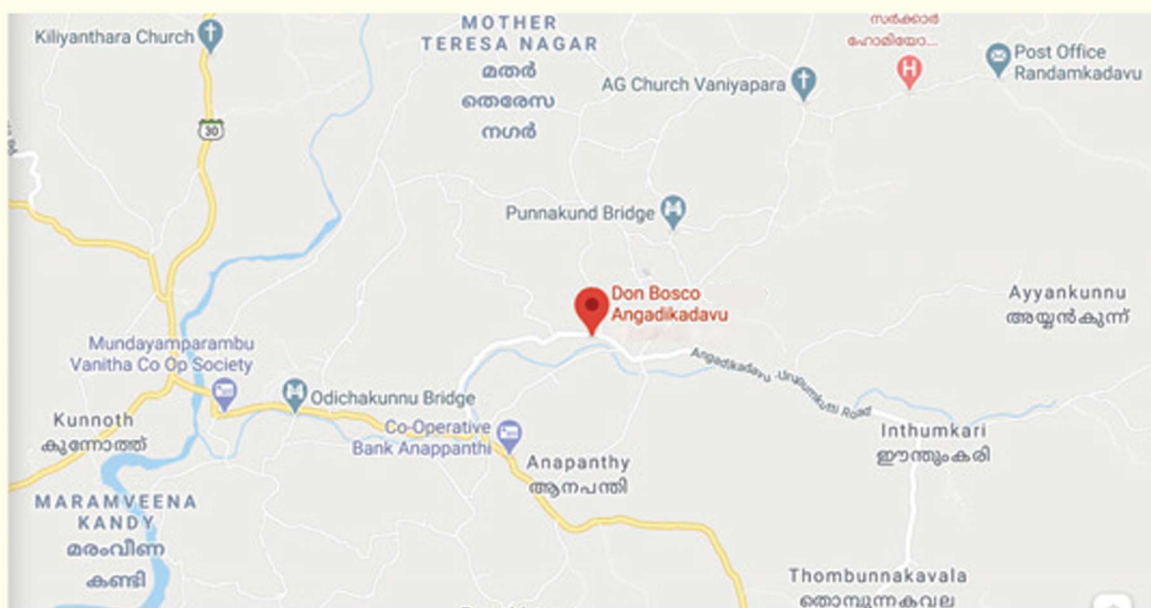


- e. Any sort of activity, which has a political bias either directly or indirectly, is strictly banned inside the campus.
